

1. Introduction

Export Import Bank of Bangladesh PLC (A Member Bank of Sammilito Islami Bank PLC.), one of the most recognized banks in Bangladesh, intends to renew licenses for the existing Cisco firewalls. The firewall brand will be Cisco, and only partners listed as authorized Cisco partners in Bangladesh will be eligible to participate in the bid. Sealed quotations for the supply, installation, and commissioning of licenses to the existing Cisco Firewalls have been invited from the listed Cisco partners in Bangladesh to be submitted within the stipulated timeframe mentioned in the General Terms and Conditions of this RFP.

2. Scope of Work

Bidders are required to propose a system as specified in the technical and financial proposal for the supply, installation, and commissioning of licenses to the existing Cisco firewalls.

The scope of the bid includes the supply, installation, and commissioning of licenses to the existing Cisco firewalls as described below in this document.

Bidders may bid for the above items. Bidders must participate in the item in which they offer their bid.

The successful bidders shall be responsible for the product offered by them for project management and coordination of the supply, installation, and commissioning for the implementation of said item, including training. The offer should include the design in these documents and any other necessary items not mentioned.





4. Deliverables licenses for the existing Cisco Firewalls

1. The successful bidder will provide an implementation plan for the supply, installation and commissioning of licenses to the existing Cisco firewalls.
2. The successful bidder will do onsite installation, configuration, and commissioning of licenses for the existing Cisco firewalls.
3. After completion of license installation, an integration test should be carried out to determine the project's operability.
4. The successful bidder will have to provide documentation, including implementation details and all necessary information.

5. Bidder's Qualification Criteria

1. The bidder must be a Gold or Premium partner/authorized dealer of the items offered in the RFP. A copy of the necessary certification is to be enclosed.
2. The bidder must have a similar kind of work experience for at least five (05) years. A copy of the necessary certification is to be enclosed.
3. The bidder should have a minimum of 03 (three) crore taka in work experience with similar types of goods under a single contract or work order in the last 5 (five) years. The bidder must submit a completion certificate and work order/contract with the bid documents. Otherwise, the bidder would be treated as nonresponsive.
4. The bidder must have ISO 9001 certification for the Quality Management and Information Security Management Standard.
5. The bidder must have 03 (three) vendor-certified engineers on the proposed OEM of the Cisco firewall.
6. The bidder must provide a list of key technical personnel, along with their CVs, vendor certifications, and proof of employment for the project.

6. General terms and conditions

1. The bidder shall prepare technical and financial proposals separately. The bidder shall seal the financial & the technical proposal in two different envelopes clearly marked as **"TECHNICAL PROPOSAL" & "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL."** All pages of the bid shall be signed by a person or individuals duly authorized to sign on behalf of the bidder. The forwarding letter should include the contact person's name, address, and telephone number along with the technical proposal.
2. The participating bidders must offer the product. Partial offers for the product will not be accepted.
3. The bidder must deliver the licenses within two (02) weeks from the date of the work order.

4. Sealed quotations have to be submitted in original and addressed at the following no later than **25-02-2026 at 5:00 PM**

5. Bid prices must be quoted in BDT. The payment will also be made in BDT.
6. The bidders should quote the price in figures and in words, and there should not be any cutting/erasing/overwriting.
7. All quoted prices should be inclusive of VAT, income tax, and all other taxes and charges. (if any)
8. All quoted price should include supply, installation, commissioning, etc.
9. The replacement warranty period shall commence with the commissioning of the devices for one (01) year, inclusive of on-site support for labor and parts. The SLA will have to be signed between the bank and the successful bidder to ensure smooth support during the warranty period. The bidder has to provide a draft SLA to cover the warranty period support along with the offer.
10. The bid submitted by the bidder shall remain valid at least for a period of 60 days.
11. The price quoted in the financial bids would be considered the final price for the evaluation. However, the bank reserves the right to negotiate with any bidder for a downward revision in the price.
12. The bank reserves the right to issue a work order for partial delivery of the equipment/software/license as and when required and in a phased manner.
13. The bank reserves the right to relax, change, or drop any of the terms and conditions of the schedule without any further notice.
14. Emphasis will be given to the quality and technical specifications of the item(s). So, the bank is not bound to accept the lowest bid. The bank reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the quotations without giving any reasons whatsoever.
15. The bank reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time before awarding the contract, without any liability to affected bidders or any requirement to inform them of the reasons for its action.
16. The designated offsite training must be arranged by a vendor-certified trainer located in a foreign country (depending on availability) for 04 (four) bank officials, with all associated expenses, including airfare, hotel costs, local travel, and food, to be covered by the bidder.
17. Documents required to be submitted by the bidder along with the offer. (The bidder should furnish the followings paper serially in their offer.)

- a) Full particulars of the ownership, constitution, year of incorporation, and main business activities of the bidder.
- b) List of the owners of the firm/partnership/directors of the company.
- c) Copies of the audited annual report for the last financial year.
- d) A copy of a valid trade license.
- e) A copy of the TIN certificate with last year's tax certificate.
- f) A copy of the VAT registration certificate (last year).
- g) Copy of authorized partnership/distributorship certificate of manufacturer, where applicable.
- h) List of professionals for maintenance and service.
- i) List of major clients in financial institutions and copies of certificates issued by such financial institutions regarding supply, installation, and configurations of quoted hardware/software to such banks.
- j) Tk 10,00,000/- (Taka Ten Lac) only through PO/DD or bank guarantee in the name of Export Import Bank of Bangladesh PLC (A Member Bank of Sammilito Islami Bank PLC.) having a validity of at least six months has to be submitted as a performance guarantee by the winning bidder within two days of receiving the work order. The performance guarantee of the successful bidder will be released after satisfactory supply, installation, and commissioning of all the items as per the work order. If the bidder fails to deliver, install, and commission the items as per the terms and conditions of this RFP, the performance guarantee shall be forfeited.

7. Technical Documentation

Technical information in the form of Brochures/Manuals/CD etc. must be submitted in support of the Offer made along with

6. The Bidder must submit Manufacturer Authorization Form (MAF) from OEM

8. Other Terms and condition

8.1. Technical presentation

After submission of the response to the RFP, the bidder may be asked to give a comprehensive presentation on the complete solution offered to the bank at a mutually agreed date and time to the bank. The presentation shall include the complete technical details of the proposed solutions in line with the requirements spelled out in this RFP and the proposed implementation plan. The presentation will also give the bank an opportunity to clarify issues arising out of the

review of the bidder's response to this RFP. The bank shall not be under any obligation to bear any part of the expenses incurred by the bidders for the presentation.

8.2. Amendment to the RFP documents

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of RFP response, the Bank may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, amend the RFP documents. Amendments will be provided in the form of an addendum to the RFP documents and will be sent in writing, or by fax or email, to all prospective bidders who have purchased the RFP documents and will be binding on them. It will be assumed that the bidders in their RFP response have taken amendments contained in such addendums into consideration.

8.3 Order Cancellation

The bank reserves its right to cancel the entire/unexecuted part of the Work Order at any time by assigning appropriate reasons in the event of one or more of the following conditions:

1. Delay in delivery beyond the specified period for delivery.
2. If applicable, there is a delay in implementation that extends beyond the prescribed period from the date of the Work Order.

9. Payment terms and condition

Export Import Bank of Bangladesh PLC (A Member Bank of Sammilito Islami Bank PLC.) will make payment as per below terms and conditions:
